

Eurasia, in search of universal values A talk by Lord Stephen Green

Home to two thirds of world population and two thirds of world economy, Eurasia is also the birthplace of all the world's major living cultures.

- How does the past unite and divide the 80 or so countries of the region?
- What are the commonalities they all share?
- How are they going to face the challenges of contemporary world, from migration to AI and emerging technologies?

Lord Green served as chairman of HSBC (2006 – 2010), and minister of trade and investment in the British government, retiring in 2013. He is currently Chair of Asia House and the Natural History Museum, an ordained priest in the Church of England, and a member of the House of Lords. His new book, *A Human Odyssey: East, West and the Search for Universal Values*, which came out on 19 September 2019 at SPSK Publishing, is a tour de force through both geopolitics and intellectual values.
